

The New Zealand International Wine Show 2024 Conditions of Entry

1. Judging

Wines will be judged on a 100-point basis

Double Gold Medal *

Gold Medal * 95 - 97points Silver Medal 90 - 94 points Bronze Medal 85 - 89 points

Recall Judging

All wines awarded 93 points or above by the respective senior judging panel will be rejudged, using new samples, before a final medal score is confirmed. No wine will be awarded a Gold Medal without a second and comprehensive assessment using the recall system. The Chief Judge and the Assistant Chief Judges will also assess all recalled wines.

- ** A Double Gold Medal will be awarded in the recall assessment when a wine receives a unanimous gold medal rating from the Chief Judge, the three assistant Chief Judges and the respective senior judging panel.
- 2. Wines from any country, supplier, producer or agent can be entered. Only wines made from grapes can be entered.
- 3. Entry fee per wine is NZ\$90 including GST.

International entries can pay by direct credit or by using the credit cards Visa, MasterCard or American Express. Credit card is the preferred payment method for international entries.

Note: Direct credit payments must include reference to the winery making the deposit.

- There will be no refunds of entry fees for withdrawals made within 7 days of the commencement of judging
- There will be no refunds of entry fees for wines that do not arrive in time for judging
- 4. Volumes required for judging are:

1 x 2L, 3L or 4 Litre: Cask

- All wines entered become the property of the NZ International Wine Show

Please clearly mark cartons with NZ International Wine Show Wine Judging Samples

For companies sending wine from overseas, please mark cartons clearly with "Wine Judging Samples". The sender is responsible for any import charges or customs fees.

- 6. No unfinished tank or barrel sample can be entered and the wine supplied for judging must conform in both quality and style to that made available for sale in the general marketplace.

 Quality audits may be made by the Chief Judge, whose decision will be final.
- 7. Wines can be entered without finished labels provided the wine can be supplied with full legal retail presentation by the time of the Awards Event.
- 8. The use or promotion of any award, medal or trophy can only be used in association with the label of the wine as entered into the competition, e.g. the award cannot be used to promote a wine bottled under a different label irrespective of it being the identical product.
- 9. Entrants will not be supplied with their judging results until entry fees have been paid in full.

The medal results are embargoed until 30th September 2024. Entrants may not use or promote the medal results in any way until then.

The Trophies will be announced at the Awards Event – Friday 18th October. All entrants are required to abide by the restrictions on the use or publication of the results and failure to comply with these rules may result in the cancellation of medals and awards.

Note: Entering a wine for judging in the New Zealand International Wine Show will be accepted as automatic acceptance of the promotional fees and conditions applicable to the show. Only Trophy winners, gold medal and double gold medal wines are subject to these fees.

Promotional Fees

These promotional fees are <u>only applicable to wines that win gold medals & double gold medals</u> and are automatically included in **The Champions List - \$NZ250 plus GST per wine.**

The promotional fee, applicable only to Trophy winning wines is \$NZ595 plus GST per wine.

All entrants with wines included in the Champions List are required to provide free of charge for use at the Awards Function, The Champions List Tasting and for promotional purposes the following:

• 6 bottles of each gold medal / double gold medal winning wine

Entering a wine for judging in the New Zealand International Wine Show 2024 will be accepted as automatic acceptance of the promotional fees and conditions listed above.

Note: Entrants will not be sent judging class labels.

These will be applied at the competition venue by the organisers.
